## WHAT WE DO:

Camp Bulova is a year-round respite program for families with children with intellectual and related disabilities and medically complex conditions. The program is held one Saturday a month, September to June from 9:30 AM to 3:30 PM for up to 15 children. The program may be offered on additional Saturdays if funding permits.

Eligibility requirements are that the children be residents of the Greater Hartford area and are age 3 through 21. There is a fee of \$60 per session.

## SERVICES PROVIDED:

- ▶ 1:1 Staffing ratio due to the medically complex natures of our participant's medical needs
- ▶ A nurse is on duty to manage participant's medical needs (for example, we have three participants with cerebral palsy who are on feeding tubes)
- ▶ Each month there is a different theme with activities created to support the theme. A favorite for many of the children is the December holiday season when they are visited by Santa and receive presents from Toys for Tots
