BIRTH-TO-THREE (Stepping Stones)

Children learn and develop faster during the first three years of life than any other time. Early intervention during these years helps many children overcome developmental delays. Everyday routines and experiences provide the best opportunities for a child to learn and succeed in the ever changing world.

Our qualified professionals provide supports and services in the child's natural environment such as the home, daycare or in the community. SERVICES PROVIDED:

Intake and Evaluation: Once your referral comes to Harc's Birth-to-Three program, families will receive personal contact from our office staff who will assist in scheduling an eligibility evaluation and provide key information to help each family move through the process smoothly.

Service Coordination: The family and child will be assigned a Services Coordinator who will be the primary contact and work with additional professionals whose expertise may be needed.

Birth-to-Three Professionals: Our program consists of a variety of support professionals who may be involved based on the child's needs.

Community Collaborations: Harc's Birth-to-Three program works with other agencies which may be involved with the child, such as daycare, local school districts, and the child's Health Professionals.
