
Another Group from Supported Employment used one of the new vans to go to work. By the way... they all loved it!



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


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March To Your Own Beat With Kibu 🕻

There are over 350 videos on this platform that help educate our individuals. From tutorials on how to go shopping, use an ATM, to Chair Yoga, American Sign Language courses, and even sparring classes with Heavyweight boxing champion Mike Tyson!

A cool feature about Kibu is that we can request a video if they do not have the content we are looking for to share with our individuals. We are integrating this platform with Residential and our Supported Employment program.

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
